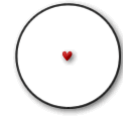

Admissions Process

We have a **year-round open registration** that encourages potential students to begin their education without extended delays. Student may begin class on any Monday.

Payment Options:

For first time students, tuition is due on your first day on class (4 weeks). There after tuition is due one week before the next 4 week session begins. Payments may be made in the administration office.

Placement:

A test will be administrated on the first day of class for appropriate program placement.

Another test will be administered every four weeks to evaluate your level.

Small Group Classes:

Classes are limited to 12 students, ensuring **greater personal attention and opportunities to participate**. Our students come from all over the world. Majority is from Japan, Korea, Brazil, France, Germany, and many other non-English speaking countries.

Certificate: Upon completion of studies, each student is awarded the California Association of Language Schools Certificate of Achievement.

Eligibility: Any student, regardless of academic, personal or occupational goals, may enroll in any class for which he/she is qualified as determined by the Director. The minimum age for international students is 16.

Housing:

Available accommodations include apartments, hotels, American Home stay, and international dorms. The SDUIS staff will assist you in finding the right accommodation for you before you arrive. Please contact us for further information, or e-mail iep@sduis.edu.

Visa Process

To study English in the United States, you will need an F -1 Student Visa. To apply for a student visa you need to present an I -20 form. SDUIS is authorized by Federal Law to issue I-20 Student Visa Form. This process takes approximately 30 days. If you need to have issued an I-20 form, please apply as early as possible.

→ Once SDUIS receives your application form, an I-20, and a letter of acceptance is sent to you. You must take your passport, I-20 and financial documentation to apply for an F-1 student visa to the US embassy or Consulate in your country. After obtaining the visa, you can enter the US with your passport, I-20, and financial documentation.
